Event or Admin Volunteer

Support Coco with administrative duties like online community/group moderation, donor relations/phone banking, and social media content creation, or join us as event support.

Event Volunteers: Individuals can be available to support Coco staff for in-person events. Job duties include event registration, set up, clean up, gift bag stuffing, and social media engagement. This is a one-day commitment.

Administrative Volunteers: Individuals can volunteer (intern) to support staff with social media content creation and posting, hosting social media webinars, donor management tasks like fundraising solicitation and email follow-ups, and project management for major events and fundraising campaigns.

Subject Expert

Share your knowledge and skills through a webinar or online event. Subject matter experts will have an identified skill and breadth of knowledge in an area of wellness that aligns with the organization's focus. Experts will volunteer their time being facilitators for webinars or online events.

Fundraising Captain

Individuals who are passionate about the mission and have philanthropic networks can spearhead individual fundraising efforts through peer-to-peer campaigns, or other unique fundraising activations.

Brand Ambassador

For those who want to spread the news about what Coco does in their networks, we'd love for you to amplify our programs, services, and resources. Brand Ambassadors will be responsible for sharing organizational updates, announcements, events, resources, and fundraisers to their network to extend Coco's reach and visibility. Simple social media sharing, spreading word of mouth, email, text, etc., are methods of communication.
